

<u>Trail Building</u> - There are plans to connect and improve trails around Philpott Lake and volunteers will be needed! No experience necessary.

**Beach Watch** - The rangers at Philpott Lake have many important duties, these include making sure that visitors have fun safely. You can help them out by signing up for beach watch at one of the parks. Free training is provided.

<u>Water Quality Testing</u> - Help us protect your waterways by monitoring the status of water quality in Philpott Lake and its tributaries. Training is provided.

<u>Outings</u> - Assist in organizing and guiding group outings at Philpott; use your knowledge of the Lake and its Parks to make sure that others appreciate it as much as you do.

Trash Pickup - Help keep Philpott Lake and its parks clean and healthy by picking up litter.

**Fundraising** - Play a major role in implementing projects to improve Philpott's parks, camping areas, playgrounds, trails, signage and access points by helping to raise the necessary funds.

<u>Interpretive Programs/Presentations</u> - Pass along your knowledge of the environment and culture surrounding Philpott Lake by presenting to groups of visitors.
