

# **2013 Annual Activities Report**



















In 2013, DRBA partnered with over a dozen communities to build trails, construct river access and develop master plans for outdoor recreation. DRBA was in almost fifty schools providing environmental education and conservation presentations. DRBA cleaned up over 100 miles of river and 30 miles of trails during the year.



# RECREATION

#### **RIVER ACCESS**

- In Martinsville/Henry County, VA, improvements to the river access area at the Sports Complex include construction of new access steps and Eagle Scout enhancement projects.
- In Stokes County, NC provided signage at Moore's Campground river access.
- In Rockingham County, NC
  - Continued to provide oversight for maintenance at Settle's Bridge access and assisted with access enhancement at Drapers Landing.
  - o Advisory role for proposed river access at Berry Hill Bridge, Rockingham County
  - Signs on all river bridges in Rockingham County, NC
  - Ongoing assistance to Mayo River State Park to establish new river access at 135 bridge
  - o Participation on river access improvement committee for Town of Madison

# **TRAILS**

  - o Completed Pathways Plan (greenway and trail plan)

- In Spencer, VA, completed Spencer Penn Centre Trail (.25 mile).

- At Philpott Lake, helped to add trails at Jamison Mill Park, Horseshoe Park and Salthouse Park (3 miles).

#### **ACTIVITIES**

- Monthly outings for the public on rivers and trails across the basin.
- Special member outings, including a tour of a LEED Certified Buffalo Farm in Patrick County, VA
- The Outdoor Recreation Advisory Committee (ORAC) was formed in Fall 2013 as a forum for discussion regarding the current state of outdoor recreation in Danville, Pittsylvania, and Caswell Counties. Results of an online survey emailed to stakeholders indicate that ORAC should continue as one singular committee focused on inter-organizational collaboration with a clear facilitator or organizer (DRBA). There was also overwhelming agreement that the committee's focus should be on promotion of outdoor recreation opportunities available in the area.

# **EDUCATION**

## TROUT IN CLASSROOM

- Completed 9th year of Trout in Classrooms (TIC) with 42 tanks in five county school systems.
- Provided education for over 2,000 students and adults about the importance of healthy rivers and trout fisheries through DRBA's TIC program.
- Held 20 trout release events on the Smith River with additional educational activities including Tub-O-Bugs for students and public.
- Engaged state and local government officials in trout release days
- Secured funding for and hired part-time TIC coordinator for Rockingham County

- Provided 12 hours of environmental training for the Upward Bound/MHC After 3
   Summer Camp to over 100 students

- Presented Trout in the Classroom Program to numerous clubs and organizations
- "Bug Daze" and other events to educate children about importance of macroinvertebrates
- Facilitated numerous Eagle Scout projects in MHC; River access ramp improvement, tree ID sign project at Gravely Nature Preserve, Wildlife observation deck at Smith River Sports Complex.

## **VOLUNTEER WATER MONITORING**

 Citizen Water Quality program was launched in Martinsville/Henry County focused on the Smith River and local streams. Training was provided by DEQ and monitoring began



with ten volunteers at 6 sites.

## WATERSHED LITTER CLEANUP

- Organized 30-mile cleanup of Smith River
- Developed Rockingham County Clean Waters event (60 miles of navigable rivers)
- Organized various cleanups on rivers and trails throughout the basin
- For Engage Dan River Region's "Day to Engage" on October 3, 2013, DRBA hosted a clean-up of the Riverwalk Trail in Danville, VA. The Averett Men's Soccer team (approximately 20 people) participated in the service project. As part of the clean up, participants used Flip Ultra Video Cameras to record the project, footage of which is being used to generate a volunteer recruitment video for DRBA.
- DRBA signed a Cooperative Agreement (effective 12/13-5/14) with the Caswell County Partnership for Children (CCPFC). CCPFC's Teen Outreach Program has agreed to adopt the Caswell County Senior Center trails in Yanceyville, NC as a service learning project. The students from Dillard Middle School and Bartlett Yancey High School are responsible for cleaning the trails twice a month, completing a nature survey of the trails, and creating promotional brochures to promote the trails in the community.
