



Bluebird Nest Box

Provided materials: Built by a local builder of long-lasting cypress lumber, with 2 coats of polyurethane

Includes:

- 1. Birdhouse with nesting cup
- 2. Green mounting t-post
- 3. Snake guard (baffle)
- 4. Mounting hardware

Materials needed: Phillips screwdriver for screw on side of bird house to open and close, mallet or t-post driver to pound t-post into ground

Installation Instructions

1. Choose a location facing east or south in an open area.



2. Pound the green t-post into the ground, burying the "wings."



3. Install the conduit pipe onto the top hole of green t-post about 4" from the top using the provided screw and materials.





4. Slide stove pipe baffle over conduit pipe. It should slide down over the t-post.



5. Fasten the bird house onto the top of the conduit pipe using the provided screw and materials.



6. Open the house to be sure the nest cup is in an upright direction. The screw on the side tightened or loosened will allow the house to be opened or closed.
