

# CITIZEN WATER QUALITY MONITORING

Volunteers generously donate their time to monitor sites along our waterways every month, but there are costs for testing supplies, training and data management. DRBA reaches 10,000 young people a year through its hands-on environmental education programs designed to change the way students interact with the world around them. Unfortunately, we have to turn away dozens of educators who contact us every year asking for our programs. Your sponsorship of DRBA's Eco-Learning Programs can help ensure that every child can experience our award-winning programs, which provide powerful learning opportunities that combine in-classroom learning with an outdoor experience.

#### **Trout in the Classroom (TIC)**

The TIC program connects SOL and CORE learning requirements and gives students a once-in-a-lifetime experience to watch the trout life cycle from eggs to fingerlings, to participate in lessons and activities, and to complete the learning experience by releasing a trout fingerling into the local Smith River in the Spring.

Grade level: 2nd

Program Duration: December - May

Field Trip: Visit a trout tank (optional), Trout release (optional)

Sponsor a TIC Classroom! \$4,000

#### **Streamside Trees in the Classroom (STIC)**

Through a partnership with the Army Corps of Engineers at Philpott Lake, students root native Black Willow cuttings in the classroom, monitor and document their growth, and finally plant their trees along a waterway in need of restoration. Students work as a team to care for the growing trees and later complete the program through a mentoring relationship with high school students and local natural resource partners to plant the trees and learn about the environment on their planting day.

Grade level: 4th

Program Duration: September - October

Field Trip: Planting Day

Sponsor a STIC Classroom! \$1,000

#### Access to a year of Eco-Learning Programs

Give a classroom in your community the opportunity to participate for a year in DRBA's Eco-Learning Programs. Programs are chosen by the students and include monthly adventures like a River Experience, BioBlitz, Campus-wide Water Conservation Campaign or Recycling Program, Water Quality Monitoring, Scavenger Trail Hunt and dozens of other EE programs.

Grade level: K-12

Program Duration: Fall or Spring
